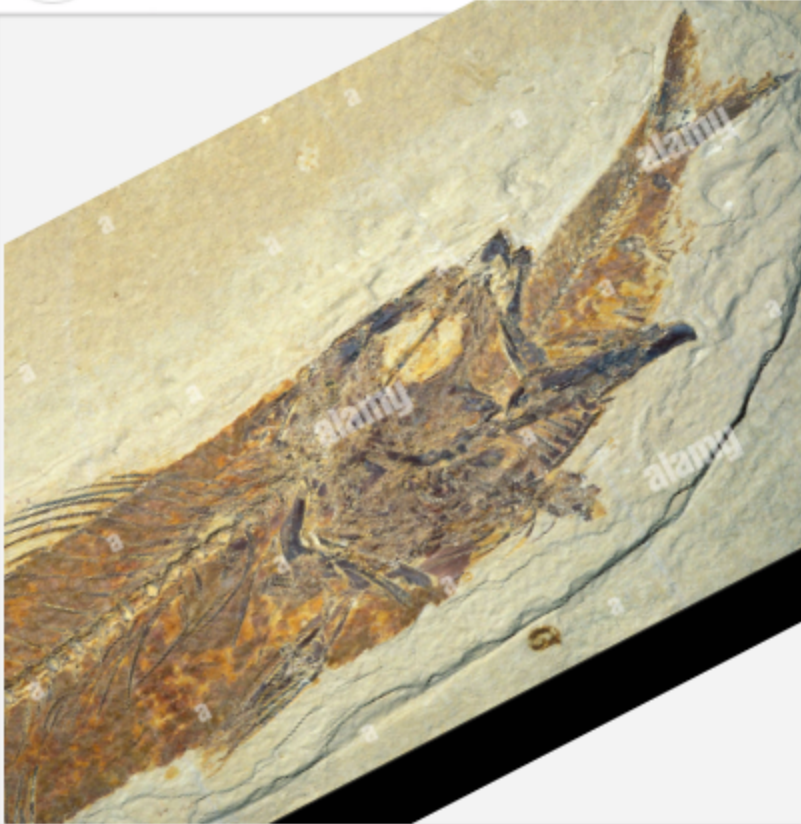

It seems *Mioplosus labracoides* fish often died trying to eat too much!! That could make them go extinct! The mouth of this perch-like fish was lined with numerous tiny sharp teeth. This aided in grasping prey, but also prevented letting go of a prey that was too big (Geology.com).



The sediments of the Green River Formation are some of the best in the world for preserving animals. It records over 6 million years of time! Sediments were deposited in very fine layers each year. A dark layer formed during the growing season and a light-hue inorganic layer in the dry season.
